As plans are finalized for SAPHIRE NOW and 2012 ASUG Annual Conference, there are a few guidelines regarding sound that SAP and ASUG would like to reiterate to ensure that everyone has the best experience.

- No noisy or obstructive work will be permitted during the official show hours of the conference.
- SAP and ASUG reserve the right to restrict exhibits, method of operation, and materials that become objectionable due to noise.
- All sound systems must be directed inward, that is toward the exhibit space, and cannot point toward the aisles.
- SAP and ASUG shall have the sole discretion in determining what is noisy, obstructive and objectionable.

If an exhibitor expects to have Public Address (PA) equipment as part of their booth, they should contact Joseph Venturella to ensure their company is aligned with the Noise Guidelines and therefore avoid any noise disturbances while attending the event.
