

## Supplemental Show Floor Lighting

When creating a lighting plan, exhibitors should take into consideration that the show floor lighting is low. Convention center “house” lighting will not be in use. Some level of ambient lighting will be provided, but the halls will not be blanketed in light.

It is important for exhibitors to provide enough lighting within their own exhibit space to conduct business and highlight their displays according to their company’s taste and guidelines.

**Due to low lighting on the show floor, exhibitors should plan to provide their own lighting or purchase supplemental lighting.**

### Important to Remember

- For Sapphire, Onyx and Diamond level exhibitors, suspended lighting grids ONLY, are permitted to a maximum height of 24 ft. Lighting equipment must be located within the exhibit space and shine into the booth area only. Lighting should not create a distraction to the show or other exhibits.
- For Sapphire, Onyx and Diamond level exhibitors, any filters or audio-visual screens that the lighting is shining on must not exceed the 22 ft. height restriction.
- For Emerald and Ruby level exhibitors, suspended lighting grids are not permitted.
- Lighting for Emerald Turnkey, Ruby Turnkey and Pod level exhibitors is included as an exhibit package component, therefore no action is necessary.
- Bright flashing lights are not permitted.
